Who Are We?

New Bloomfield city is a friendly small community centrally located off Highway 54 ten miles SW of Fulton, ten miles N of Jefferson City (the State Capitol), and 15 miles from Ashland/Columbia. It's a convenient 1.5 hour drive to St. Louis, a 2.5 hour drive to Kansas City, and only 45 minutes from Lake of the Ozarks, a popular tourist attraction south along Highway 54.

The New Bloomfield community is a great place to raise a family while enjoying highway access to larger urban areas. Residents and businesses enjoy a low crime rate thanks to the New Bloomfield Police Department and supporting Callaway County Sheriff's Department.

New Bloomfield schools are some of the finest in the state, offering small classroom sizes and personalized teaching for Pre-school through 12th grade. School sport activities include baseball, softball, basketball, cross country, track, golf and cheerleading.

The New Bloomfield community includes several large housing subdivisions including: Hiller's Creek, Heritage Meadows, Ryan's Lake, Country Club Estates, Chestnut Acres, Milanda Lake; as well as the surrounding Guthrie community. Additionally, New Bloomfield hosts a substantial farming and equestrian community.

The City and several community organizations host events throughout the year. A Farmer's Market is held by the New Bloomfield Area Civic Association during the late spring and summer months each year.
